PARENT EDUCATION Viral Croup

Croup is a viral infection of the voice box, resulting in a barky cough. The following instructions may help to improve the symptoms:

- 1. Cool mist vaporizer is helpful in the child's room.
- 2. The cough may improve by taking child outside in the cool night air.
- 3. Keep your child calm e.g. holding, rocking, etc. When the child is excited or crying, breathing will be noted to be worse.
- 4. Tylenol for fever as directed.
- 5. Encourage fluids but do not give your child anything to drink or eat if your child is having difficulty breathing or breathing too fast.
- 6. It is recommended that you keep your child home away from other children until he or she is better and to wash your hands carefully after caring for your sick child.
- 7. Bring your child immediately to the ER if your child has excessive drooling with high fever or severe symptoms breathing difficulty or changes in skin or lip color.
